I am directed to state that on consideration of the observations made by the Expert-Committee and the recommendations made by the Southern Regional Committee, State Level Committee and Central Task Force as per the provisions of AICTE regulations 304-4/CCF/REG/94 dated 31.10.94. and also the recommendations of State Govt. of Tamil Nadu vide letter ref. 74458A/31/95 dated 6.7.96, the All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE), has accorded conditional approval to BANNARIAMMAN EDUCATIONAL TRUST, 252, METTUPALAYAM ROAD, COIMBATORE - 641 043 for the establishment of BANNARI AMMAN INSTITUTE OF TECHNOLOGY, ALATHUKOMBAI, VILLAGE, SATHYAMANGALAM 638 401, PERIYAR DIST. and to conduct following degree course(s) in ENGINEERING & TECHNOLOGY with an annual intake mentioned against each for the session 1996-97.

The admission will be made in accordance with Regulations notified by the AICTE vide GSR 476(E) dated 20.05.1994, based on the hon'ble Supreme Court Judgement dated 04.02.1993 with regard to W.P(C) No. 607 of 1992 in the case of Unni Krishanan JP and other etc. V/s. State Government of Andhra Pradesh and others etc. and later judgements. No Management/Institute/Trust or Society shall announce admissions directly under any circumstances. Any action contrary to this provision taken by the Institute will make it liable to be derecognised.

Further in the event of infringement/contravention or non-compliance of the conditions prescribed by the AICTE by December 1996, The Council shall take further action to withdraw approval to these cases for admission during 1997-98 and the liability arising out of such withdrawal of approval will be solely that of Management/Trust/Society and/or Institutions.

You are requested to kindly monitor the progress made by these institutions for fulfillment of conditions laid down in this approval and keep the Southern Regional Committee and AICTE informed.



Specific Conditions :

1. Though a RCC type building attached with AC sheet buildings has not been taken on lease for a period of 2 years from 1st March, 1996 to provide temporary accomodation the infrastructural facilities such as labs., workshops , drawing halls, computer room , class rooms., library etc. are not readily available for running the first year classes of the proposed engg. college at the time of the visit of the expert committee. These facilities should be created immediately.

Other infrastructural facilities should be created prior admissions.

2. The adequate finances should be provided for meeting recurring and non recurring expenses of the proposed institution.

3. One Principal, HOD and teaching & non teaching staff should be appointed and gradually brought at par with the AICTE norms.

4. AICTE scales of pay alongwith applicable allowances should be granted to the teaching and non teaching faculty.

5. The institution should create an endowment fund jointly in the name of the institution and the concerned State authority to the tune of 30% of the projected peak annual recurring expenditure or as prescribed by State Govt./ Union Territory or Rs. 10 lakhs whichever is more.

6. The institute should use the proposed area exclusively for the engineering college.

7. The construction work of building at permanent site should be completed with 6 to 8 months and action plan for the phased wise construction of buildings should be submitted to AICTE immediately.

8. Library facilities for the first year classes alongwith necessary furniture, books, journals etc. including reading room as per AICTE norms should be created.

9. Infrastructural and other facilities in terms of faculty, laboratories, workshops, library etc. for the first year and subsequent years of classes should be established in the new campus well in advance before the actual commencement of that year.

10. This approval is subject to establishing the proof of availability of funds minimum to the tune of Rs.:40 lakhs and rectification of the deficiencies in terms of infrastructural facilities pointed out by the expert committee before admissions of students for the session 1996-97.

An AICTE Expert Committee shall visit and verify these facilities prior to admissions.

ANNEXURE II

General Conditions

1. No new course(s) shall be started or an ongoing course(s) shall be discontinued without the prior approval of the AICTE.
2. The intake capacity in any of the approved course(s) shall not be increased or varied without the prior approval of the AICTE.
3. Adequate funds shall be available with the Institution to meet the financial obligations of recurring and non-recurring nature as prescribed by the AICTE, from time to time.
4. All infrastructural, instructional and other facilities shall be provided as per the AICTE norms prescribed from time to time.
5. Teaching and other staff shall be selected according to the procedure, qualifications, experience and pay scales as prescribed by AICTE from time to time, and that they shall be paid full salaries and allowances regularly and in time.
6. The tuition and other fees shall be charged as prescribed by the State Government within the overall criteria/limits as may be laid down by the AICTE from time to time.
7. Admissions shall be made according to the regulations and directions of the AICTE for such admissions in the respective technical institution or university.
8. The State Government policies for admissions of SC/ST, other weaker sections of Society etc., shall be followed by the Institution.
9. Institution by virtue of the approval by AICTE shall not automatically become eligible to receive financial grants or assistance from the Central or State Governments.
10. Institution shall maintain records and books of accounts as prescribed by the Competent Authority.
11. The Accounts of the Institution shall be audited by Chartered Accountant or any agency authorised by the Competent Authority and shall be open for inspection by the AICTE or any body authorised by it.
12. The Institution shall be subject to a Special Audit and inspection as prescribed by the AICTE.
13. Institution shall furnish requisite returns as prescribed by Competent Authority/AICTE for ensuring maintenance of standards.
14. The Institution may be visited by an officer or a Committee of the AICTE or of its Regional Office from time to time to review the progress made by the Institution in fulfilling the conditions as laid down by the AICTE.

Additional Conditions for Pvt. and Grant-in-Aid technical institutions :

15. The Governing Body of the institution shall be constituted, and its Chairman shall be appointed as per the guidelines of AICTE.
16. The institution shall not charge any Capitation Fee or donation for admission or other higher charges from the students/guardians of the students in any form.
17. The Institution shall constitute a Planning and Monitoring Board (PMB) for the continuous monitoring of implementation of norms and standards of the AICTE. There shall be an evaluation of the Institution in a plan period by the AICTE.
18. The institution should create an Endowment fund jointly in the name of the institution and the concerned State Authority to the tune of 30% of the projected peak annual recurring expenditure or as prescribed by the State Govt./UT or Rs. 10 lakhs, whichever is more.


Conditions of Affiliation

1. Each and every one of the recommendations of the Commission should be implemented (copy of the Inspection Report is enclosed) as stipulated by the Commission.
2. The College should have permanent buildings and sufficient accommodation for the proposed courses.
3. The maximum number of students that may be admitted should not exceed the sanctioned strength for each of the above course at any cost.
4. Library and Laboratory facilities should be provided as suggested by the Commission.
5. A full time Principal possessing the prescribed qualifications has to be appointed within a period of three months and necessary approval for the same be obtained from the University.
6. The recruitment of teaching be made immediately as per the qualifications prescribed by the AICTE and this University.

7. The College shall provide the required buildings, equipment and other essential facilities as per the norms and standards laid down by the AICTE/Bharathiar University.
8. Facilities should be made available for conducting University Examinations.
9. A College Committee may be constituted immediately in accordance with the Tamilnadu Private College (Regulation Act) and informed to the University.
10. In accordance with the order of the State Government
 - i. the Management/Education Agency of the College shall not collect Capitation fee/Donation from the students or their parents who seek admission to the college.
 - ii. the intake for the above said course should be filled up strictly according to the rule of reservation prescribed by the Government from time to time.
11. The College should satisfy all the conditions as prescribed in the Chapter 24 of the Bharathiar University Statutes (copy enclosed).
12. The College shall follow all guidelines/procedures issued by the Govt. of Tamilnadu and this University with regard to admissions of candidates.
13. If the conditions prescribed for the Provisional Affiliation granted are not complied with, the University reserve the right to withdraw the affiliation forthwith.
14. All conditions prescribed by the AICTE, New Delhi in its letter F.No.730-52-283(E)/ET/96 dt. 19.7.96 shall be fulfilled by the College.
15. The college shall move to the permanent site approved by the State Govt. and AICTE before the beginning of the next academic year 1997-98.
15. Such other conditions as may be prescribed from time to time by the University should also be complied with.

- v. Balaji College of Engineering, Kancheepuram.


3. It is ascertained from the Bharathidasan

has been received from the AICTE.


