Baby Mithra is a 23-month baby suffering from a genetic disease called Spinal Muscular Atrophy (SMA). The ailment affects the central nervous system which makes patient unable to sit up



and lift the head, and is characterized by weakness and wasting (atrophy) in muscles. The treatment for the same requires a mammoth expense of over 16 crores, and the family is seeking all possible contributions from the kind-hearted to cover the medical expenses.


SPECIAL GENERAL BODY MEETING (SGM)

Yirtual Meeting with Representatives of Alumni Chapters



Yirtual Meeting with EC members for Mobile App Development




AABIT Review Meeting on Mobile App Development
