The IQAC Coordinator presented the quality initiatives through IQAC, which are as follows:

- ❖ The details of the competency training provided to non-teaching staff members, Interns and securities through various training programmes are listed below.
 - 5 different training programs were attended by 109 non-teaching staff members, Interns and security guards. The training programs provided are Ms Excel, Google Form, Pivot table, Safety training and Security training.
 - A Total of 5816 students from all the four years attended the skill training provided through day skill, night skill and special lab initiatives and faculty initiatives.
 - A total of 2 industrial training sessions were attended by 6 faculty members and they provided training for other faculty members and students through Special Lab and Gurugulam.
 - 3 Faculty members from our institute have provided training for industry persons on industrial safety and Advanced Excel – Power Pivot and Power Query. Total of 183 industry persons attended the training.
