- Informed about the implementation of Minor Degree / Honors for the B.E. / B. Tech. students who have been admitted from the academic year 2021-2022 onwards. The guidelines and conditions for the categories were presented.
- The details of the end semester examination process along with the action taken for the issues were reported.
- The report on the Internal Academic Audit II was presented. The sample report for the departments of AIML, BME and EEE was presented with the observations of the audit.
- The graduation survey details for the batch 2017-2021 was presented. Totally,
 985 UG graduates and 64 PG graduates submitted the survey.
- It is informed that 7222 lesson plans and lecture materials and 8407 video lectures were developed by the Faculty members and uploaded on BIT-Wiki for 428 courses.
- The statistics of the discourse forum were presented and the number of Lessons discussed are 5524.
- 6621 students and 698 faculty members have been involved, and 499 questions have been raised and answered in the discourse forum.

The Head-IQAC presented the quality initiatives through IQAC, which are as follows:

- The details of the competency training provided to Teaching, Non-teaching staff members, mess workers and students through various training programmes are listed below:
 - The training program on QP setting, LP Preparation and CO-PO mapping was attended by 99 teaching faculty members; 6 different training programs (Workplace Ethics, Safety training, audio video training, etc.,) were attended by 228 non-teaching staff members and mess workers; The training programmes were arranged for the students through the various skill training programmes which are listed below:

- A total of 21 industrial training sessions were attended by 34 faculty members and they provided training for other faculty members and students through Special Lab and Gurugulam.
- Two Faculty members from our institute have provided training for the industry persons on New product development, etc. Total of 36 industry persons attended the training.
- ❖ Three grievance meetings were conducted for the faculty members and three meetings for the students during the assessment period. The number of grievances reported, the no. of grievances that should be addressed and the actions recommended were presented.
- The statistics of the feedback received from the students through the support desk QR code was presented.
- ❖ Informed that the faculty orientation programme was conducted for all the newly joined faculty members.

❖ A Seminar on "Research Integrity" has been organized by the Department of Agricultural Engineering & IQAC - Research & Development (R & D). Chief guest, Distinguished Professor Dr. Digvir S. Jayas, University of Manitoba has delivered the seminar. 50 students and faculty members have participated.

- The Head-IQAC has provided the information on participation and accomplishments of faculty members and students during the assessment period.
 - 62 Students have participated in National level Competitions and 10 students have won prizes.
 - In the paper presentation, 585 papers were presented in International level and 431 papers were presented in National level events. 22 papers were awarded with best paper recognition.
 - 4256 projects were presented at national level and 94 projects were presented in International level events. Among that, 102 projects won prizes.
 - The events organized during the assessment period were presented followed by the statistics of achievements by faculty members.
- The awards and rankings applied by the institute were presented with details of Awards applied / ranking / survey in 4 different categories.
- ❖ The NBA Committee visited the departments of AGRI, Auto, EEE, EIE, IT and MTRS on 2-3 December, 2022. The AGRI department has been awarded with the accreditation for 6 years and other departments have received accreditation for 3 years.
